## Animal Rescue

HALO Animal Rescue would like to advise its potential adopters of the three major viruses and infections that are commonly seen in a shelter environment and in post-adoption.

Canine Distemper Virus, (CDV), is a highly contagious viral disease of dogs and can affect them at any age. CDV may be misdiagnosed due to its wide range of clinical manifestations. Common symptoms are gastrointestinal, neurological and/or respiratory in nature. Dramatic and sporadic increases in body temperature are a telltale sign of the infection. Behavioral changes include lethargy and depression. Neurological signs include muscle twitching (especially near the mouth and legs) and possible seizures or paralysis. A skin sign in dogs with CDV is the hardening of footpads and nose pad most evident in older dogs. Sudden death is not uncommon with this disease.

<u>Parvovirus Enteritis</u>, or "Parvo", is characterized by vomiting, diarrhea, dehydration, dark and bloody feces, and in severe cases, fever and lack of appetite. Acute Parvovirus Enteritis can be seen in dogs of any breed, sex, or age. The disease will progress very rapidly and death can occur as early as two days after the onset of the disease. There is a broad range of severity of symptoms. Many adult dogs exposed to the virus show very few, if any, symptoms. The majority of cases of this disease are seen in dogs under 6 months of age with the most severe cases seen in puppies younger than 12 weeks of age.

<u>Canine Infectious Respiratory Disease (CIRD)</u>, better known as "Kennel Cough", are characterized by a persistent cough, difficulty breathing, sneezing, and ocular or nasal discharge. The infection is highly contagious and can cause numerous respiratory problems in your pet. Pets left untreated can lead to pneumonia, lethargy, disinterest in food and water and a high fever.

If you observe any of these symptoms or if you ever suspect your pet is unwell, you should take your pet to a veterinarian immediately. Failure to initiate immediate treatment will significantly lower your pet's chance of survival.

HALO Animal Rescue will always ensure to uphold our facilities to the highest sanitation standards and make every effort to limit the spread of disease both in the maintenance of our kennels and through the vaccination of our pets. However there is no guarantee that can be made towards the health of the animal. There is always the risk that the pet you are adopting may have contracted a disease that they are not yet showing symptoms of. If you notice any of the symptoms listed on this page or suspect the pet may be unwell at the time of adoption, please bring this to the attention of your adoption counselor. Once the adoption is completed and the pet passes through our front doors, we can no longer provide any medical care for the pet and all treatments and medications become the sole responsibility of the adopter.

I hereby fully and completely release HALO Animal Rescue and its officers, employees, and agents from any claim, cause of action, damages, losses, costs, expenses and liabilities of any kind of nature. I assume all financial responsibility for any further treatment required and will not hold HALO responsible in any way. I agree to keep my new companion separate from all other pets for ten days, and where applicable I will keep my puppy from any public areas where there are other dogs until he/she is a minimum of 20 weeks old and fully vaccinated.
