

## Materials

Note: 1/2 a yard of fleece will make two small-medium size heart toys, including stuffing.

Micro Fleece Fabric Scissors Pen or Fine Tip Marker Heart Stencil (optional, or freehand!)

## DIY: No Sew Heart Dog Toy Tutorial

- 1. Stack two layers of fleece on a flat surface and trace a heart shape with a fine tip marker or pen.
- 2. Keeping the two layers stacked, cut a circle approximately 2 inches around the outside the heart. We want to leave enough length to double tie our knots.
- 3. Cut two slits on the edge of the heart about the width of your finger.
- 4. Using the bottom and top pieces, tie a knot. Double knot it to make sure it is extra tight and secure. Repeat steps 3 &4 until you have the majority of the heart tied.
- 5. With a small hole still remaining, fill the heart using your extra fleece as stuffing.
  Avoid using tiny pieces as stuffing. Long wide strips work best!
- 6. Continue cutting and tying until the heart is completely sealed.
- 7. Trim the edges and start playing!

**Note:** These DIY toys are **not** recommended for rough chewing. Remember to always supervise your pet during playtime.
